## POLICE INVESTIGATING COMMERCIAL BREAKING & ENTERING

SUFFOLK, Virginia (April 20, 2017) Suffolk Police are investigating a commercial breaking and entering that occurred early this morning at the T-Mobile store in the 1200 block of North Main Street.

Emergency Communications was made aware of the incident at 1:19 a.m.

Upon preliminary investigation it was found that 5 males, all believed to be juveniles wearing hoodies, entered the business after breaking the glass in the front door and left approximately 1 minute later after taking several electronics items.

Video surveillance footage and photos accompany this release.

Anyone with information is asked to contact Crime Line at 1-888-Lock-U-Up. When calling Crime Line, callers do not have to give their names or appear in court.
