

“Bear Crossing” Sign (W11-16)

The City Traffic Engineer may, at his discretion, erect a “Bear Crossing” sign in locations where bear frequently cross the state roadway and/or at accident locations involving bear. Typical locations which might be appropriate for such installations are areas with a history of accidents and areas with sight distance restrictions. This sign is not intended to be installed within subdivisions or on dead-end or unpaved roads due to slow speeds and local traffic conditions. Consideration of the engineering study may include but is not limited to traffic volumes, approach speeds, street design and condition, sight distance, accident history, and frequency of crossing.

** When a review of accident history reveals that no bear-car related accidents have occurred in the study area within a 12 month period, the sign may be removed at the discretion of the City Traffic Engineer.*
