


City of Suffolk Chesapeake Bay Preservation Area Overlay District



The Virginia General Assembly enacted the Chesapeake Bay Preservation Act (CBPA) which requires all Tidewater Virginia localities to establish local programs to protect and improve water quality in the Chesapeake Bay watershed and its tributaries. The purpose of the City of Suffolk Chesapeake Bay Preservation Area Overlay District is to protect and improve water quality by reducing stormwater runoff, and as such all land located within the CBPA Overlay District is subject to special restrictions to prevent damage to water quality.
