Williams, property owners, to permit the expansion of existing playing fields for Nansemond Suffolk Academy in accordance with Sections 31-306 and 31-406 of the Unified Development Ordinance. The property affected is located to the south of Nansemond Suffolk Academy and is further identified as Tax Map 25, Parcel 57C and a portion of 57B, Suffolk Voting Borough, Nansemond Taxing District, Zoned A, Agriculture
