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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (November 9, 2016) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Wednesday, November 9, 2016, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a shoulder closure on the Godwin Boulevard on-ramp from westbound Route 58 and a westbound lane closure on the overpass on Godwin Boulevard from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(West Riverview Drive) – A contractor has West Riverview Drive closed between Butler Avenue and North Broad Street for road and washout repair. Accommodations will be made for residents and emergency vehicles.

(North Main Street) – A contractor will have a southbound outside lane closure on North Main Street between the 7-Eleven and Northgate Lane and an outside left turn lane closure on Godwin Boulevard at North Main Street. This closure will be 24 hours a day for up to two weeks, October 31st through November 14th.

(Badger Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have the 2900 block of Badger Road closed for bridge repair from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have a southbound lane closure in the 2600 block of Bridge Road for utility work from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. This work zone will be intermittent for the next 6 months.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a mobile operation eastbound and westbound on Route 58 between Holland and the Chesapeake City line for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.

(North Liberty Spring Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation in the 600 block of North Liberty Spring Road for a pipe repair from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Longstreet Lane) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Longstreet Lane between Pittmantown Road and Route 58 for pothole patching from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Wilroy Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Utilities Line Maintenance will have a lane closure in the 1400 block of Wilroy Road for utility work from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.

(Gates Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a lane closure in the 8000 block of Gates Road for a drainage pipe installation from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(North Main Street) – A contractor will have an outside lane closure northbound on North Main Street between VDOT and Northgate Lane for concrete paving of the crosswalk. The lane closure will be in place for a minimum of 24 hours.

Upcoming Projects:

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a westbound right lane closure in the 3100 to 3400 block of Godwin Boulevard for a turn lane installation from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Ongoing Projects:

(Arthur Drive) – A contractor will be demolishing and reconstructing bridges over Spivey Run and Langston Swamp on Arthur Drive. A detour will be in place to direct motorists with the detour in place. This closure will remain until the estimated completion date of January 31, 2017.

(Highland Avenue) – A contractor will be installing a new pump station and sewer and water lines on Highland Avenue between Kingsboro Street and the end of Highland Avenue at the cul-de-sac. This project will continue through June 2017.

(Seaboard Trail) – A contractor will have the Seaboard Trail from Main Street to Moore Avenue closed to all pedestrians until further notice. The contractor is estimating a December completion date.

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
