POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAY – SUPER LOAD MOVES

SUFFOLK, VA (November 8, 2016) Two super load moves, each involving a mobile home, could cause delays in traffic. The first move will be at 1 p.m., Wednesday, November 9, 2016 and the second move at 1 p.m., Thursday, November 10, 2016.

With each super load move, the truck will begin the journey in North Carolina and travel through Suffolk on northbound Route 32 to northbound Route 13 to the Route 13/32 Bypass to westbound Route 58 to Manning Road and will end in the 1100 block of Manning Road.

Each truck and load will measure 14 feet 6 inches tall, 16 feet wide, 76 feet long, and weigh 54,000 pounds.

The move will have certified front and rear escorts as well as Suffolk Police escorts.
