REMEMBER TO RECYCLE WHEN YOU REPLACE YOUR SMOKE ALARM BATTERIES

SUFFOLK, VA (November 3, 2016) Wondering what to do with those old batteries from your smoke alarms when you change them this weekend? Suffolk Public Works and the Suffolk Clean Community Commission (SCCA) is currently providing battery recycling containers throughout the City of Suffolk. The containers are for household single-use and rechargeable batteries only, including AAA, AA, C, D and 9V.

Batteries may be recycled at all Suffolk Libraries, the East Suffolk Recreation Center – 138 S. 6th Street, Farm Fresh locations – 1401 N. Main Street and 3575 Bridge Road, Lowe's – 1216 N. Main Street, Suffolk Department of Public Works – 442 W. Washington Street, 2nd Floor, Suffolk Police Department Headquarters - 111 Henley Place, Suffolk Police Department Sector II – 3901 Bridge Road, the Virginia Cooperative Extension Office – 440 Market Street, 3rd Floor, and the Hilton Garden Inn – Suffolk Riverfront (Maintenance Office).
