SUFFOLK TRANSIT TO INTRODUCE PILOT TRANSIT SERVICES TO NORTHERN SUFFOLK AND CONNECTOR SERVICE TO CHESAPEAKE SQUARE

SUFFOLK, VA (July 31, 2014) Beginning Monday, August 4, 2014, Suffolk Transit will introduce pilot transit bus routes to Northern Suffolk and a connector between Downtown Suffolk, Chesapeake Square and Northern Suffolk.

The Blue Route will originate at the North Suffolk Library, 2000 Bennetts Creek Park Road, and serve the Northern Suffolk areas of Belleharbour, Harborview, Huntersville, College Square, Hampton Roads Crossing, Burbage Grant and Pughsville. The route will provide service to residential, medical and business locations throughout that region of Northern Suffolk.

The Gold Route will originate at the Suffolk Transfer Station, located at the intersection of Main Street and Prentis Street. The Gold Route will provide connector service to the HRT transfer point located on Portsmouth Boulevard in Chesapeake, near the former Kmart location, and continue to the North Suffolk Library where transfers can occur to the Blue Route before returning to the Downtown Suffolk Transfer Station.

Service for the Blue Route will run hourly from 6:30 a.m. to 6:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. The Gold Route will be offered five times daily, Monday through Friday.
