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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (November 3, 2016) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Thursday, November 3, 2016, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a shoulder closure on the Godwin Boulevard on-ramp from westbound Route 58 and a westbound lane closure on the overpass on Godwin Boulevard from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(West Riverview Drive) – A contractor has West Riverview Drive closed between Butler Avenue and North Broad Street for road and washout repair. This closure is expected to remain until Friday evening.

(North Main Street) – A contractor will have a southbound outside lane closure on North Main Street between the 7-Eleven and Northgate Lane and an outside left turn lane closure on Godwin Boulevard at North Main Street. This closure will be 24 hours a day for up to two weeks.

(Pine Street) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Pine Street at Market Street from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Badger Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have Badger Road closed between White Marsh Road and the 2900 block for bridge repair.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a mobile operation westbound on Route 58 to the Southampton County line and Route 189 for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.

(Johnson Avenue) – A contractor will have a shoulder closure on Johnson Avenue at Spruce Street from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Main Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering Signal Crew will have the outside lane closed southbound on Main Street at Prentis Street from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.

(Carolina Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation northbound and southbound on Carolina Road between Cypress Chapel Drive and Babbtown Road for milling and paving from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.

(Charlotte Avenue) – A contractor will have a paving operation on Charlotte Avenue from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have a southbound lane closure in the 2600 block of Bridge Road for utility work from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. This work zone will be intermittent for the next 6 months.

Ongoing Projects:

(Arthur Drive) – A contractor will be demolishing and reconstructing bridges over Spivey Run and Langston Swamp on Arthur Drive. A detour will be in place to direct motorists with the detour in place. This closure will remain until the estimated completion date of January 31, 2017.

(Highland Avenue) – A contractor will be installing a new pump station and sewer and water lines on Highland Avenue between Kingsboro Street and the end of Highland Avenue at the cul-de-sac. This project will continue through June 2017.

(Seaboard Trail) – A contractor will have the Seaboard Trail from Main Street to Moore Avenue closed to all pedestrians until further notice. The contractor is estimating a December completion date.

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
