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### **ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS**

SUFFOLK, VA (November 7, 2016) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Monday, November 7, 2016, due to construction and maintenance projects.

#### **New Projects:**

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a shoulder closure on the Godwin Boulevard on-ramp from westbound Route 58 and a westbound lane closure on the overpass on Godwin Boulevard from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(West Riverview Drive) – A contractor has West Riverview Drive closed between Butler Avenue and North Broad Street for road and washout repair. Accommodations will be made for residents and emergency vehicles.

(North Main Street) – A contractor will have a southbound outside lane closure on North Main Street between the 7-Eleven and Northgate Lane and an outside left turn lane closure on Godwin Boulevard at North Main Street. This closure will be 24 hours a day for up to two weeks, October 31<sup>st</sup> through November 14<sup>th</sup>.

(Badger Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have the 2900 block of Badger Road closed for bridge repair from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have a southbound lane closure in the 2600 block of Bridge Road for utility work from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. This work zone will be intermittent for the next 6 months.

(Hosier Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on Hosier Road between Badger Road and White Marsh Road for ditch maintenance from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.

(Shoulders Hill Road) – A contractor will have the right turn lane onto Shoulders Hill Road closed southbound on Bridge Road from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a mobile operation westbound on Route 58 between Route 272 and the Blackwater Bridge then eastbound on Route 58 from the Pitchkettle Road exit to the Chesapeake City line for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.

## **Ongoing Projects:**

(Arthur Drive) – A contractor will be demolishing and reconstructing bridges over Spivey Run and Langston Swamp on Arthur Drive. A detour will be in place to direct motorists with the detour in place. This closure will remain until the estimated completion date of January 31, 2017.

(Highland Avenue) – A contractor will be installing a new pump station and sewer and water lines on Highland Avenue between Kingsboro Street and the end of Highland Avenue at the cul-de-sac. This project will continue through June 2017.

(Seaboard Trail) – A contractor will have the Seaboard Trail from Main Street to Moore Avenue closed to all pedestrians until further notice. The contractor is estimating a December completion date.

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
