



## NOTICE OF INTENT TO APPLY FOR U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) FUNDING

The City of Suffolk hereby provides notice of intent to apply for a U. S. Department of Justice, Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG). The City of Suffolk is requesting \$37,711 in JAG funding for equipment and training for the Police Department and training and supplies for the Commonwealth's Attorney's Office.

A draft copy of the application is being prepared and will be available for public review and comment in the Suffolk Police Department at 111 Henley Place. The deadline for submission of the grant application is July 10, 2013. Comments on the proposed JAG application will be accepted until Thursday, July 3, 2014.
