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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (November 17, 2016) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Thursday, November 17, 2016, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a shoulder closure on the Godwin Boulevard on-ramp from westbound Route 58 and a westbound lane closure on the overpass on Godwin Boulevard from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Nansemond Parkway) – Suffolk Department of Public Utilities Line Maintenance will have a lane closure in the 3500 block of Nansemond Parkway for utility work with traffic control setup from 10:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

(Godwin Boulevard, Pruden Boulevard, Carolina Road) – A contractor will have mobile operations on Godwin Boulevard, Pruden Boulevard, and Carolina Road for debris pick-up from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(North Main Street) – A contractor will have the inside lanes, northbound and southbound, and the two-way left turn lane closed on North Main Street between VDOT and Murphys Mill Road. This closure will be in place 24 hours per day, November 16th through November 22nd.

(Nansemond Parkway) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 1200 block of Nansemond Parkway at Patriots Walk from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a westbound outside lane closure on Route 58 at the scales on November 17th overnight from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have alternating lane closures and a left lane shoulder closure eastbound on Route 58 between the Nansemond Parkway overpass and the Route 58 on-ramp at Portsmouth Boulevard for a milling and paving operation. Milling will take place overnight from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. and the paving will take place daily from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., November 13th through November 18th.

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a westbound right lane closure in the 3100 to 3400 blocks of Godwin Boulevard for a turn lane installation from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., November 14th through November 18th.

(Carolina Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on Carolina Road between Babbtown Road and Cypress Chapel Road for milling and patching from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Moore Avenue) – A contractor will have a lane closure in the 300 block of Moore Avenue from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Upcoming Projects:

(Holland Road) -- Suffolk Department of Public Utilities will have a lane closure on Holland Road at Grove Avenue to remove jersey barriers from 6 a.m. to 7:30 a.m., November 19th.

Ongoing Projects:

(West Riverview Drive) – A contractor is continuing work on West Riverview Drive between Butler Avenue and North Broad Street for road and washout repair. Accommodations will be made for residents and emergency vehicles.

(Arthur Drive) – A contractor will be demolishing and reconstructing bridges over Spivey Run and Langston Swamp on Arthur Drive. A detour will be in place to direct motorists. This closure will remain until the estimated completion date of January 31, 2017.

(Highland Avenue) – A contractor will be installing a new pump station and sewer and water lines on Highland Avenue between Kingsboro Street and the end of Highland Avenue at the cul-de-sac. This project will continue through June 2017.

(Seaboard Trail) – A contractor will have the Seaboard Trail from Main Street to Moore Avenue closed to all pedestrians until further notice. The contractor is estimating a December completion date.

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
