ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (October 31, 2016) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Monday, October 31, 2016, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a shoulder closure on the Godwin Boulevard on-ramp from westbound Route 58 and a westbound lane closure on the overpass on Godwin Boulevard from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have the outside westbound lane closed for paving and milling on Route 58 between Brentwood Road and OKelly Drive from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(White Marsh Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on White Marsh Road between Hosier Road and Clay Hill Road for ditch maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Various Locations) – A contractor will have a mobile operation at the following locations: Whaleyville Boulevard, Route 13/32 Bypass and Holland Road for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.

(Bute Street) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Bute Street at West Washington Street from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have the westbound outside lane closed on Route 58 at the scales from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.

(Godwin Boulevard) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation westbound on Godwin Boulevard between Willow Lane and Kings Highway for a sidewalk install from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(West Riverview Drive) – A contractor has West Riverview Drive closed between Butler Avenue and North Broad Street for road and washout repair. This closure is expected to remain until Friday evening.

(Main Street) – A contractor will have a southbound outside lane closure on Main Street between the 7-Eleven and Northgate Lane. This closure will be for 24 hours a day for up to two weeks.

Upcoming Projects:

(Badger Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have Badger Road closed between White Marsh Road and the 2900 block for bridge repair, November 1st through November 7th.

Ongoing Projects:

(Arthur Drive) – A contractor will be reconstructing bridges over Spivey Run and Langston Swamp on Arthur Drive. A detour will be in place to direct motorists with the detour in place. This closure is expected to be complete by December 30, 2016.

(Highland Avenue) – A contractor will be installing a new pump station and sewer and water lines on Highland Avenue between Kingsboro Street and the end of Highland Avenue at the cul-de-sac. This project will continue through June 2017.

(Seaboard Trail) – A contractor will have the Seaboard Trail from Main Street to Moore Avenue closed to all pedestrians until further notice. The contractor is estimating a December completion date.
