MULTI-VEHICLE ACCIDENT S. QUAY ROAD

SUFFOLK, VA (October 24, 2016) Suffolk Police and Suffolk Fire & Rescue responded earlier this afternoon to a multi-vehicle accident in the 7100 block of South Quay Road.

Emergency Communications received the call at 11:58 a.m. advising of the accident involving three passenger vehicles.

Suffolk Fire & Rescue crews responded and provided emergency medical assessment and treatment to those involved and one adult was airlifted to Sentara Norfolk General Hospital with non-life threatening injuries, and four adults were ground transported to a local hospital with non-life threatening injuries.

Both westbound lanes were closed immediately following the accident, with the roadway reopening at 12:46 p.m.

The cause of the accident remains under investigation.
