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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (November 21, 2016) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Monday, November 21, 2016, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(West Washington Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Utilities Line Maintenance will have a lane closure at the 1000 block of West Washington Street from 11:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.

(Carolina Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering's paint crew will have mobile lane closures on Carolina Road between Fayette Street and Washington Street from 12:30 p.m. to 6 p.m.

(Butler Avenue) – A contractor will have Butler Avenue closed between West Riverview Drive and Allen Street from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Route 58) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a shoulder closure westbound on Route 58 between the Route 10 on ramp and overpass from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Bridge Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have the right turn lane closed on Bridge Road at Harbour View Boulevard from 9 a.m. to 11 a.m.

(Nansemond Parkway) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 1200 block of Nansemond Parkway from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(South Quay Road) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on South Quay Road for debris pick up from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a mobile operation east and westbound on Route 58 between the 13/32 Bypass and Route 460 for debris pick up from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(West Riverview Drive) – A contractor will continue working on West Riverview Drive between Butler Avenue and North Broad Street for road and washout repair. Accommodations will be made for residents and emergency vehicles.

(Carolina Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation north and southbound on Carolina Road between the Route 13/32 Bypass and the NC state line for debris pick up from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Whaleyville Boulevard) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation north and southbound on Whaleyville Boulevard between Carolina Road and the NC state line for debris pick up from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(North Main Street) – A contractor will have the inside lanes north and southbound and the two-way left turn lane closed on North Main Street between VDOT and Murphys Mill Road. This closure will be in place 24 hours per day for the dates listed. Heavy traffic patterns should be anticipated.

Ongoing Projects:

(Arthur Drive) – A contractor will be demolishing and reconstructing the bridges over Spivey Run (#8033) and Langston Swamp (#8034) on Arthur Drive. A detour will be in place to direct motorists. This closure will remain until the estimated completion date of January 31, 2017.

(Godwin Boulevard on ramp from Route 58 WB) – A contractor will have a shoulder closure on the Godwin Boulevard on ramp from Route 58 westbound and a westbound lane closure on the overpass on Godwin Boulevard from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. daily.

(Highland Avenue) – A contractor will be installing a new pump station and sewer and water lines on Highland Avenue between Kingsboro Street and the end of Highland Avenue (at the cul-de-sac). This project will continue through June 2017. More details to follow.

(Seaboard Trail) – A contractor will have The Seaboard Trail between Main Street and Moore Avenue closed to all pedestrians until further notice. Contractor is estimating a December completion date.

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
