ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (November 15, 2016) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Tuesday, November 15, 2016, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a shoulder closure on the Godwin Boulevard on-ramp from westbound Route 58 and a westbound lane closure on the overpass on Godwin Boulevard from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(North Main Street) – A contractor will have a northbound outside lane closure and southbound inside lane closure on North Main Street between VDOT and Murphys Mill Road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Bridge Road, Nansemond Parkway, Kings Highway) – A contractor will have mobile operations on Bridge Road, Nansemond Parkway, and Kings Highway for mowing and debris pick up from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.

(Route 58) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering Paint Crew will have turn lanes closed on westbound Route 58 between OKelly Drive and Brentwood Road from 12:30 p.m. to 4 p.m.

(Holland Road) – A contractor will have a westbound outside lane closure in the 3500 to 3800 block of Holland Road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Whaleyville Boulevard) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation in the 5000 to 6000 block of Whaleyville Boulevard for ditch maintenance from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have alternating lane closures eastbound on Route 58 between the Nansemond Parkway overpass and the Route 58 on ramp at Portsmouth Boulevard for a milling and paving operation. Milling will take place overnight from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. and the paving will take place daily from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., November 13th through November 18th.

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a westbound right lane closure in the 3100 to 3400 block of Godwin Boulevard for a turn lane installation from 12 p.m. to 4 p.m., November 14th through November 18th.

Upcoming Projects:

(Moore Avenue) – A contractor will have a lane closure in the 300 block of Moore Avenue from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., November 17th.

(Holland Road) -- Suffolk Department of Public Utilities will have a lane closure on Holland Road at Grove Avenue to remove jersey barriers from 6 a.m. to 7:30 a.m., November 19th.

(Nansemond Parkway) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 1200 block of Nansemond Parkway from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., November 16th.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have an eastbound lane closure on Route 58 at the scales on November 16th and a westbound lane closure on Route 58 at the scales on November 17th overnight from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m.

Ongoing Projects:

(West Riverview Drive) – A contractor has West Riverview Drive closed between Butler Avenue and North Broad Street for road and washout repair. Accommodations will be made for residents and emergency vehicles.

(Arthur Drive) – A contractor will be demolishing and reconstructing bridges over Spivey Run and Langston Swamp on Arthur Drive. A detour will be in place to direct motorists with the detour in place. This closure will remain until the estimated completion date of January 31, 2017.

(Highland Avenue) – A contractor will be installing a new pump station and sewer and water lines on Highland Avenue between Kingsboro Street and the end of Highland Avenue at the cul-de-sac. This project will continue through June 2017.

(Seaboard Trail) – A contractor will have the Seaboard Trail from Main Street to Moore Avenue closed to all pedestrians until further notice. The contractor is estimating a December completion date.
