UPDATE

SUFFOLK, Va. (March 6, 2009) According to a Dominion Power database, there are currently 619 Suffolk customers without power as a result of the tree on the line. Their representatives at the scene estimate power will be out for an additional two hours.

SUFFOLK, Va. (March 6, 2009) A tree on a power line has resulted in power outages in downtown Suffolk. At approximately 8:30 a.m., a large tree fell onto a power line at E. Constance and Katherine St. As a result, power outages are being experienced in the core downtown area. Numerous traffic lights are not functioning.

Dominion Power is currently on scene. Traffic is being re-routed around the incident. It is unknown how many residential and business customers are without power or how long the service will be interrupted.
