City Offices Closed In Observance of Independence Day

In observance of Independence Day, Suffolk City offices will be closed Friday, July 3, 2009. Normal operations will resume Monday, July 6, at 8:30 a.m. The city observes all state-designated holidays. Independence Day is considered a holiday for the Commonwealth of Virginia, and all state offices are closed on these days.

All **Suffolk City libraries** will be closed Friday, July 3, and Saturday, July 4, and will reopen on Monday, July 6, at 9 a.m. The **Suffolk Museum** will be closed Friday, July 3, through Monday, July 6, and will reopen on Tuesday, July 7, at 10 a.m. The City's **Tourism Visitor Center** will remain open on Friday, July 3, and Saturday, July 4.

Suffolk's four major parks – Lone Star Lakes, Constant's Wharf, Sleepy Hole, and Bennett's Creek will remain open throughout the holiday weekend; however, no park attendant will be on duty.

The Public Works Department will follow the regular trash pick up schedule. Trash must be placed at curbside no later than 7 a.m. on the day of collection. For more information on refuse collection, please call Public Works at 514-7630.
