Suffolk Announces Second Annual Street Festival

SUFFOLK, VA: The Second Annual Taste of Suffolk Downtown Street Festival will commemorate Suffolk's 400th Anniversary on Saturday, September 13, 2008, from 10 a.m. until 6 p.m. Spend a day in historic downtown discovering shoppes and restaurants, attractions and businesses and learn about Suffolk's rich past through exhibits highlighting the distinct villages. The downtown historic district will close to vehicular traffic along North Main Street from Finney Avenue to Washington Street and from Commerce Street to Saratoga Street along Washington Street.
