City Offices Closed In Observance of Labor Day

In observance of Labor Day, Suffolk City offices will be closed Monday, September 7, 2009. Normal operations will resume Tuesday, September 8, at 8:30 a.m. The city observes all state-designated holidays. Labor Day is considered a holiday for the Commonwealth of Virginia, and all state offices are closed on these days.

All **Suffolk City libraries** will be closed Monday, September 7, and will reopen on Tuesday, September 8, at 9 a.m. The **Suffolk Museum** will be closed Monday, September 7, and will reopen on Tuesday, September 8, at 10 a.m. The City's **Tourism Visitor Center** will remain open on Monday, September 7.

Suffolk's four major parks – Lone Star Lakes, Constant's Wharf, Sleepy Hole, and Bennett's Creek will remain open throughout the holiday weekend; however, no park attendant will be on duty.

The **Public Works Department** will pick up trash according to the following schedule:

- Monday's (September 7) route will be picked up on Tuesday, September 8
- Tuesday's (September 8) route will be picked up on Wednesday, September 9
- Wednesday's (September 9) route will be picked up on Thursday, September 10
- Thursday's (September 10) route will be picked up on Friday, September 11
- Friday's (September 11) route will be picked up on Saturday, September 12
