Parks and Recreation to Hold Summer Camp in Whaleyville

SUFFOLK, VA—June 15, 2011— Suffolk Department of Parks and Recreation announces it will once again host its popular Summer Camp in Whaleyville. This program is ideal for youth that want to have fun and for parents or guardians who want their children in a safe place! Youth will enjoy arts and crafts, games, special events, speakers and exciting field trips (T-shirt is included). The program will be held at the Whaleyville Community Center, located at 6213 Whaleyville Boulevard, beginning June 27 through August 19, 2011 from 7:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m.

The fees are per child and include a one-time registration fee of \$35 and a \$240 fee for the entire summer, or payments of \$60 which can be made every two weeks. Breakfast and lunch is provided at no additional cost. The cost of the program does not include field trips.

Registration must be completed by a parent or guardian. Individuals interested in participation can register at Suffolk Parks & Recreation Administrative Office, located at 134 S. 6th Street next to East Suffolk Recreation Center. Registration is on a first come, first served basis; only payment secures space. Proof of age and proof of residency required. Five year olds must have proof of attending kindergarten during the 2010-2011 school year. Deadline for registration is June 22.
