City Offices Closed in Observance of Independence Day

SUFFOLK, VA (June 30, 2011) In observance of Independence Day, Suffolk City offices will be closed Monday, July 4, 2011. Normal operations will resume Tuesday, July 5, at 8:30 a.m. The city observes all state-designated holidays. Independence Day is considered a holiday for the Commonwealth of Virginia, and all state offices are closed on these days.

All **Suffolk City libraries** will be closed Monday, July 4, and will reopen on Tuesday, July 5, at 9 a.m. The **Suffolk Museum** will be closed Monday, July 4, and will reopen on Tuesday, July 5, at 10 a.m. The City's **Tourism Visitor Center** will remain open on Monday, July 4.

Suffolk's four major parks – Lone Star Lakes, Constant's Wharf, Sleepy Hole, and Bennett's Creek will remain open during the holiday; however, no park attendant will be on duty.

Suffolk Parks and Recreation Departments will be closed on Monday, July 4, 2011 and will reopen on Tuesday, July 5, 2011.

Trash pickup will remain the same. Trash must be placed at curbside no later than 7 a.m. on the day of collection. For more information on refuse collection, please call Public Works at 514-7630.
