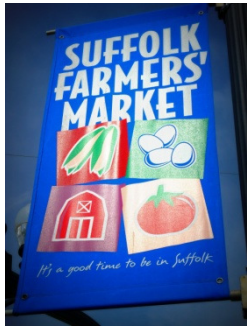

Launched in 2006, the Suffolk Farmers' Market is an open-air gathering place offering fresh, locally-grown foods, value-added products and crafts. Held beneath brightly striped tents at "Market Park" (the mini-park adjacent to the Seaboard Station Railroad Museum at 326 North Main Street), the Market will operate rain or shine on Saturdays from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. and Wednesdays from 3 p.m. to 6 p.m. through the fall.

The Market and all associated activities are free and open to the public, including Family Fun Days. From 10 a.m. until 2 p.m., Saturday, August 17, kids of all ages will enjoy visiting the farm critters of the Teeny Tiny Farms' petting zoo.
