Materials to be recycled include:

  - (#1 and #2)
- Glass containers
  - (bottles and jars)
- Steel & aluminum cans
- Alkaline batteries
  - (AA, AAA, C, D, 9V)
- All types of paper, including mixed paper
  - (magazines, catalogs and newspaper)

Participants will receive a reusable shopping bag for attending. Cintas will also be providing on-site shredding of sensitive documents. A limit of three copy-paper-size boxes or three brown paper bags per person applies. You must stay with your documents until you have handed them to the Cintas employee in the truck.
