• *Low-Cost Rabies Clinic*



A low cost rabies clinic will be held on Saturday, September 24, from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. at Suffolk Animal Control, 124 Forest Glen Drive. The clinic was scheduled in response to a record number of rabies cases in the city, and is sponsored by the Suffolk Humane Society and Suffolk Animal Control. The clinic is open to anyone (not just Suffolk residents).

Vaccinations will cost only \$5.00 and have been provided by Nansemond Veterinary Clinic. Volunteers will be available to answer questions, and vaccinations will be given on a first come, first-served basis. Suffolk Animal Control will also be selling city dog licenses for \$5 each.

• *Suffolk Farmer's Market*

Launched in 2005, the Suffolk Farmers' Market is an open-air gathering place offering fresh, locally-grown foods, value-added products and crafts. Held beneath brightly striped tents at "Market Park" (the mini-park next to the Seaboard Station Railroad Museum at 326 North Main Street), the Market will operate rain or



shine on Saturdays from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. and Wednesdays from 3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. through the fall.
