ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (October 14, 2011) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures and possible delays today, Friday, October 14, 2011, due to construction and maintenance projects:

-Turlington Road will have a single lane closure with proper signage and traffic control in place until 4:00 p.m.

-City of Suffolk Traffic Engineering Division will have left shoulder work affecting left turning traffic on east-bound Highway 58 at the Regional Landfill. The work zone will be from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. to install signal lights.

-City of Suffolk Department of Public Works crews will have a flagger operation on Godwin Boulevard between Everets Road and Kings Highway from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Minor delays are possible.

-City of Suffolk Public Works Department will have the westbound lanes of Nansemond Parkway between Helen Street and Dayle Acres and between Shoulder's Hill Road and west to the railroad tracks closed between 8:00 a.m. and 4 p.m. Flaggers will be in place for traffic control.

-Sleepy Hole Road will have flagging operations from 8:00 = a.m. to 5 p.m. as part of a storm water pipe replacement project. Flaggers will alternate traffic as needed.
