ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (October 25, 2011) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures and possible delays today, Tuesday, October 25, 2011, due to construction and maintenance projects:

- Suffolk Police advise that they have partially opened Godwin Boulevard to through traffic following this morning's tractor trailer accident. Traffic is now moving in both directions with alternate lane closings.

-City of Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagger operation on Godwin Boulevard between Everets Road and Kings Highway from 9:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. Delays are possible.

-City of Suffolk Public Works Engineering will have the westbound lane of Nansemond Parkway closed between Helen Street and Dayle Acres as well as between Shoulder's Hill Road west to the railroad tracks. Flaggers will be in place for traffic control from 8:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m.

-Carolina Road will have one lane closed in the southbound direction between the 700 block and the Southern 13/32 Bypass until 4:00 p.m.

-West Washington Street between Main Street and Saratoga will be closed from 7:00 a.m. until 4 p.m. due to utility work Monday, October 24 through Friday, October 28. The street will reopen to traffic each evening.
