- *Suffolk Ghost Walk*



Whispers of legends and lore lurk in the autumn shadows of downtown Suffolk's historic Main Street as *Legends of Main Street: A Suffolk Ghost Walk* gets underway. Suffolk Tourism successfully introduced this 90-minute guided walking tour in the fall of 2010 and has increased the tour dates for 2011 based on an overwhelming

response from the public. The Suffolk ghost walk season kicks off, with Ghost Walks departing from the Suffolk Visitor Center located inside the historic Nansemond County Courthouse at 524 North Main Street. Tickets are \$10 for adults and \$8 for seniors. This evening stroll offers a look into the persistent, sometimes eerie, occurrences of Suffolk's Main Street and beyond and is not recommended for the very young or the faint of heart.
