### **POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS – TWO SUPER LOAD MOVES**

SUFFOLK, VA (November 7, 2011) If you are traveling on southbound Carolina Road (Route 13/32) to southbound Whaleyville Boulevard (Route 13), between 9:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m., Tuesday, November 8, 2011, the Department of Public Works would like to make you aware of a super load move that could possibly cause a delay in traffic.

A mobile home, measuring 95 feet long and 16 feet wide, is scheduled to travel from the 1100 block of Carolina Road (Route 13/32) to Whaleyville Boulevard (Route 13) south to North Carolina. The move will have front and rear pilot cars along with Suffolk Police Department escorts. Both lanes of Carolina Road (Route 13/32) and Whaleyville Boulevard (Route 13) could see possible delays.

If you are traveling on southbound Carolina Road (Route 13/32) to Carolina Road (Route 13) south to North Carolina, between 10:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m., Tuesday, November 8, 2011, the Department of Public Works would like to make you aware of a second super load move that could possibly cause a delay in traffic.

A mobile home, measuring 105 feet long and approximately 16 feet wide, is scheduled to travel from the 1100 block of Carolina Round (Route 13/32) to Carolina Route (Route 13) south to North Carolina. The move will have front and rear pilot cars along with Suffolk Police Department escorts. Both lanes of Carolina Road (Route 13/32) could see possible delays.
