ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (November 14, 2011) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures and possible delays today, Monday, November 14, 2011, due to construction and maintenance projects:

- City of Suffolk Department of Public Works will have the westbound lane of Nansemond Parkway closed between Helen Street and Dayle Acres as well as between Shoulder's Hill Road west to the railroad tracks. Flaggers will be in place from 8 a.m. until 4 p.m.

- City of Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a single lane of Godwin Boulevard, between Everet's Road and Kings Highway closed until 2 p.m. Delays are possible.

- City of Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a lane shift on Sleepy Hole Road between Nansemond Parkway and the 3300 block of Sleepy Hole Road from 9:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m.

-A construction company will have a road closure with detour traffic control to surrounding streets on Wilson Street between St. James Avenue and Wellons Street until 3:00 p.m.

-City of Suffolk Public Works Traffic Engineering Division will have a mobile lane closure on Kings Highway between Bennett's Pasture Road and Lighthouse Drive from 8:30 a.m. until 2:30 p.m.

-A contractor will have a milling and paving operations on River Club Drive between Harbourview Boulevard and Sports Club Run today, Monday, November 14 through Wednesday, November 16 until 5:00 p.m. each day.

-A contractor will have a milling and resurfacing project on Whaleyville Boulevard between Babtown Road and Greenway Road today, Monday, November 14 through Friday, November 18 from 7:00 a.m. until 5 p.m. each day. A flagger operation with alternating, single lane closures throughout the work zone will be used to control traffic. Delays are possible.
