ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (November 16, 2011) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures and possible delays today, Wednesday, November 16, 2011, due to construction and maintenance projects:

- City of Suffolk Department of Public Works will have the westbound lane of Nansemond Parkway closed between Helen Street and Dayle Acres, as well as between Shoulder's Hill Road west to the railroad tracks. Flaggers will be in place from 8 a.m. until 4 p.m.

- City of Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagger operation on Godwin Boulevard between Everet's Road and Kings Highway until 2 p.m. Delays are possible.

-City of Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a lane shift on Sleepy Hole Road between Nansemond Parkway and the 3300 block of Sleepy Hole Road from 9:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m.

-A contractor will have a milling and paving operation on River Club Drive between Harbourview Boulevard and Sports Club Run until 5:00 p.m.

-A contractor will have a milling and resurfacing project on Whaleyville Boulevard between Babtown Road and Greenway Road today, Wednesday, November 16 through Friday, November 18 from 7:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. each day. A flagger operation with alternating, single lane closures throughout the work zone will be used to control traffic. Delays are possible.

-A construction company will have a flagger operation with single lane closure in 5200 block of Godwin Boulevard from 9:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m.

-City of Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a short term stationary lane closure affecting the soundbound right thru lane in the 1200 block of North Main Street from 10:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m.

-A construction company will have an eastbound right lane closure in the 4300 block of Pruden Boulevard until 3:00 p.m.
