ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (November 21, 2011) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures and possible delays today, Monday, November 21, 2011, due to construction and maintenance projects:

- City of Suffolk Department of Public Works will have the westbound lane of Nansemond Parkway closed between Helen Street and Dayle Acres, as well as between Shoulder's Hill Road west to the railroad tracks. Flaggers will be in place from 8 a.m. until 4 p.m.

- City of Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a lane shift on Sleepy Hole Road between Nansemond Parkway and the 3300 block of Sleepy Hole Road from 9:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m.

- A contractor will have a milling and resurfacing project on Whaleyville Boulevard between Babbtown Road and Greenway Road today from 7:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. A flagger operation with alternating, single lane closures throughout the work zone will be used to control traffic. Delays are possible.

-Public Utilities will be cleaning sewer lines at the 700 block of North Main Street. The southbound right lane will be closed to traffic for approximately one hour from 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. Traffic will be directed to merge over to the southbound passing lane until the cleaning is complete.

-Public Works will have a mobile flagger operation on Great Fork Road between Mineral Springs Road and the NC State line until 3:00 p.m.

-Traffic Engineering's Signal Crew will have the southbound right travel lane and the right turn lane closed on N. Main Street at the Farm Fresh shopping center from 10:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.

-Public Utilities will have a lane closure at the 700-800 blocks of East Washington Street to clean sewer lines. The lane closure will last approximately one hour from 10:00 a.m. until 11:00 a.m.
