### **ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS**

SUFFOLK, VA (November 30, 2011) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures and possible delays today, Wednesday, November 30, 2011, due to construction and maintenance projects:

- A Contractor will shift traffic on Nansemond Parkway at Shoulder's Hill Road to allow for utility work adjacent to the eastbound traffic lane during night work, tonight, November 30, 2011. Traffic lanes will be channelized with orange traffic barrels and police will direct traffic at the intersection. The westbound lane should not be affected until midweek when construction approaches the east side of the intersection. At that time, flagger operations will be utilized. The night work is planned for the next few weeks as weather conditions permit.

-City of Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagger operation on Godwin Boulevard between Everets Road and Kings Highway until 2:30 p.m.

-A contractor will have a flagger operation will single lane closure at 5200 block of Godwin Boulevard from 9 a.m. until 3 p.m.

-A contractor will have a flagger operation on Sleepy Hole Role between Kings Highway and Bennett's Pasture Road from 8:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m.

-A contractor will have a milling and paving operation on Whaleyville Boulevard between Babbtown Road and Greenway Road form 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. A flagger operation with alternating single lane closures will be utilized to control traffic. Delays are possible.

-City of Suffolk Department of Public Works will have Manning Bridge Road closed completely to make repairs to the bridge. Detours will be in place to divert traffic from 9:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.
