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UPDATE

SUFFOLK, VA (December 29, 2011) Only one of the super load moves scheduled for Wednesday, December 28, 2011, was transported last night, with the other one rescheduled for this evening, Thursday, December 29, 2011.

The truck will be heading from Norfolk International Terminals (NIT) to Garner, North Carolina, and will pass through Suffolk around 10:00 p.m. Possible delays will impact eastbound Route 58, Route 13/58/460 Suffolk Bypass, and Route 460 westbound lanes.

The load will take two lanes while traveling along the route.

SUFFOLK, VA (December 28, 2011) Due to inclement weather, the two super load moves scheduled for overnight Tuesday, December 27, have been rescheduled for Wednesday, December 28, 2011.

Each of the two loads will take two lanes while traveling along the route.

SUFFOLK, VA (December 27, 2011) The time for the two super load moves has been changed as the Virginia State permit requires the moves take place during night time hours.

The moves will come through Suffolk around 10:30 p.m. this evening, Tuesday, December 27, 2011. Possible delays will impact eastbound Route 58, Route 13/58/460 Suffolk Bypass, and Route 460 westbound lanes.

POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS – TWO SUPER LOAD MOVES

SUFFOLK, VA (December 22, 2011) Two super load moves involving trucks carrying a blower wheel could cause delays in traffic on Tuesday, December 27, 2011.

The trucks will be heading from Norfolk, Virginia to Garner, North Carolina and will pass through Suffolk around 12:00 p.m. Possible delays will impact eastbound Route 58, Route 13/58/460 Suffolk Bypass, and Route 460 westbound lanes.

The load will measure 16 ½ feet wide and have certified front and rear escorts accompanying the trucks.

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
