CITY OFFICES CLOSED IN OBSERVANCE OF INDEPENDENCE DAY

SUFFOLK, Virginia (June 29, 2010) In observance of Independence Day, Suffolk City offices will be closed Monday, July 5, 2010. Normal operations will resume Tuesday, July 6th, at 8:30 a.m. The City observes all state-designated holidays. Independence Day is considered a holiday for the Commonwealth of Virginia, and all state offices are closed on these days.

All **Suffolk City Libraries** will be closed Monday, July 5th, and will reopen on Tuesday, July 6th, at 9 a.m. The **Suffolk Museum** will be closed Saturday, July 3rd, through Monday, July 5th, and will reopen on Tuesday, July 6th at 10 a.m. The City's **Tourism Visitor Center** will remain open throughout the holiday weekend and on Monday, July 5th.

Suffolk's four major parks – Lone Star Lakes, Constant's Wharf, Sleepy Hole, and Bennett's Creek will remain open throughout the holiday weekend; however, no park attendant will be on duty on Monday, July 5th.

The Public Works Department will follow their newly established trash pick-up schedule, as effective July 6th there are now no regularly scheduled Monday refuse pick-ups. Trash must be placed at curbside no later than 7 a.m. on the day of collection. For more information on refuse collection, please call Public Works at 514-7630.
