City Offices Closed in Observance of Veterans Day

SUFFOLK, VA (November 8, 2010) In observance of Veterans Day, Suffolk City offices will be closed Thursday, November 11, 2010. Normal operations will resume Friday, November 12, at 8:30 a.m. The city observes all state-designated holidays. Veterans Day is considered a holiday for the Commonwealth of Virginia, and all state offices are closed on these days.

All **Suffolk City libraries** are closed Thursday, November 11, and will reopen on Friday, November 12, at 9 a.m. The City's **Tourism Visitor Center** will remain open on Thursday, November 11th. The **Suffolk Museum** will be closed Thursday, November 11, and will reopen on Friday, November 12, at 10 a.m.

All Suffolk **Recreation Centers** are closed Thursday, November 11. They will reopen on their normal schedule on Friday, November 12. However, there will be **no before or after school programs**. **Suffolk's four major parks** – Lone Star Lakes, Constant's Wharf, Sleepy Hole, and Bennett's Creek will remain open during the holiday; however, no park attendant will be on duty.

Trash scheduled for pick-up on Thursday November 11, will be collected on Friday, November 12. Garbage pick-up scheduled for Friday November 12 will be collected on Saturday, November 13. **Suffolk Public Works Department** reminds you that trash
