INDECENT EXPOSURE ARREST

SUFFOLK, Virginia (June 18, 2010) Suffolk Police arrested Francis Neal Totten, 45, of Virginia Beach, on June 16, 2010, on charges of Indecent Exposure and Reckless Driving. The incident occurred on June 9, 2010, as police were dispatched to the 3900 block of Bridge Road on a complaint of a reckless driver that had exposed himself. The victim stated that while heading west on Bridge Road, a white 2002 BMW pulled up beside her and stayed there. When she looked over, she saw the driver exposing and fondling himself. When the victim tried to slow down to allow the offender to pass, the offender slowed down to keep pace with her. When eye contact was made with the offender, the victim stated he sped past her and pulled in front of her and suddenly applied his brakes, causing the victim to run into the median of Bridge Road.
