Learn How to Make A Duck Decoy

SUFFOLK, VA (October 4, 2010) Instructor Ed Morrison will teach “Decoy Carving and Painting” on Saturday and Sunday, November 13 & 14, 2010 at the Suffolk Museum 118 Bosley Ave. Suffolk, VA from 9 am until 5 pm. Using Ed Morrison’s step-by-step process, anyone can carve a canvas back duck decoy. This decoy carved from bass wood can be completed in class. All materials and tools are provided. Students may wish to bring an apron.

Ed Morrison lives in Virginia Beach and has been carving since 1982. He is a member of the Back Bay Wildfowl Guild and the Albemarle Craftsman’s Guild. His working style decoys are carved with traditional spoke shaves, knives and chisels to help preserve the “old way” of folk carving in the midst of a real trend toward power carving. The fee for the 2 day workshop is \$110.00. Please make checks payable to
