## Suffolk Street Partially Closed Due to Sewer Main Replacement

SUFFOLK, VIRGINIA (October 14, 2010)—The Suffolk Public Utilities Department wants you to know about a sewer repair project which will affect traffic. The department is replacing a sewer main between the sanitary pump station located in the 1600 block of Brookwood Drive and the sewer main in the street within Brookwood Drive. Although the work area is small, the street is closed to through traffic because of how deep crews have to dig to make the repairs.

Brookwood Drive will be closed at Magnolia Drive with all traffic detoured to Camellia Drive to Maplewood Drive. However, people who live on the street will have access on Brookwood Drive at Maplewood Drive. Work is anticipated to be complete by November 1, weather permitting.
