UPDATE

SUFFOLK, VIRGINIA (December 28, 2010) Police have released the name of the person that died in this morning's accident on Pruden Blvd. David W. Williams, age 49, of the 3000 blk. of Catalina Ave. in Suffolk, died at the accident scene.

Williams was a passenger in a 2001 Chevrolet that was making a left turn from Pruden Blvd. onto Providence Rd. when it was struck by a 2007 Ford Mustang that was traveling east bound on Pruden Blvd. The female driver of the Chevrolet is currently stable at Sentara Norfolk General Hospital. The passenger in the Ford, a female, was treated and released from Sentara Obici Hospital. The driver of the Ford, a male, was not injured.

The accident remains under investigation. Officer T. L. Reynolds is the lead investigator.

UPDATE

SUFFOLK, VIRGINIA (December 28, 2010) All lanes of Pruden Blvd. reopened at 1:40 p.m. Police are continuing to investigate the accident and have confirmed that one person died at the accident scene.

POLICE INVESTIGATING PRUDEN BLVD ACCIDENT

SUFFOLK, VIRGINIA (December 28, 2010) — Suffolk Police are investigating a serious accident that occurred just after 9 a.m. The two-vehicle accident occurred at the intersection of Pruden Blvd (Rt. 460) and Lake Prince Rd.

The operator of one vehicle was transported by ground to Sentara Norfolk General Hospital. The passenger of a second vehicle was taken by ground to Sentara Obici Hospital.

Very few details of the accident and drivers are currently available. East-bound traffic on Rt. 460 is being detoured onto Lake Prince Rd. West-bound traffic is experiencing delays. Police anticipate Rt. 460 traffic to be impacted for several hours.
