CITY OFFICES CLOSED IN OBSERVANCE OF PRESIDENT'S DAY

SUFFOLK, Virginia (February 17, 2011) In observance of President's Day, Suffolk City offices will be closed Monday, February 21, 2011. Normal operations will resume Tuesday, February 22nd, at 8:30 a.m. The City observes all state-designated holidays. President's Day is considered a holiday for the Commonwealth of Virginia, and all state offices are closed on these days.

All **Suffolk City Libraries** will be closed Monday, February 21st, and will reopen on Tuesday, February 22nd, at 9 a.m. The **Suffolk Art Gallery**, formerly known as the Suffolk Museum, will be closed Monday, February 21st, and will reopen on Tuesday, February 22nd at 10 a.m. The City's **Tourism Visitor Center** will remain open on Monday, February 21st.

Suffolk's four major parks – Lone Star Lakes, Constant's Wharf, Sleepy Hole, and Bennett's Creek will remain open for regular hours on Monday, February 21st; however, no park attendant will be on duty.

All **Suffolk Parks and Recreation Centers** will be closed on Monday, February 21st, including the East Suffolk Recreation Center. Any centers scheduled for Youth League Practice will be open for those practices only.

The Public Works Department will follow their established trash pick-up schedule, of

no regularly scheduled Monday refuse pick-ups. Trash must be placed at curbside no later than 7 a.m. on the normal day of collection. For more information on refuse collection, please call Public Works at 514-7630.
