Suffolk Street Crews Prepare Traffic Controls for Peanut Fest

Suffolk, Virginia(October 7,2010) Suffolk Public Works crews are preparing to make your journey to the Peanut Fest a safe one. A dozen workers today are placing traffic control devices along a two mile stretch of Carolina Road.

The crews are putting barrels, cones, signs and message boards on Carolina Road between the RT13/RT 32 bypass and the Suffolk Executive Airport. When they are done, some 140 barrels, 140 cones, 12 signs and three message board will be there; all geared towards helping you arrive and leave the Peanut Fest safely. Suffolk Public Works wants to remind motorists to watch out for the workers while they are putting up the traffic control devices.

The 33rd annual Suffolk Peanut Fest kicks off at 2 pm Thursday, October 7, and runs through the weekend. The popular event at the Suffolk Executive Airport located at 200 Airport Road, offers a wide range of activities for the entire family. You can enjoy local, regional and national entertainment, fireworks, a shrimp feast, a demolition derby, trucks & tractor pull, peanut butter sculpture contest, carnival rides, craft exhibits and more!
