UPDATE

The intersection remains closed at this time. Suffolk Police report that a tractor trailer was leaving a stop sign at Madison Street and County Street when a passenger vehicle with the right of way heading southbound on County Street ran into the diesel tank of the tractor trailer. The driver of the passenger vehicle was taken to Norfolk General Hospital with non-life threatening injuries. Due to the diesel fuel leak, the intersection was closed and Petrochem responded to take care of the spill. The accident remains under investigation.

SUFFOLK, Virginia (June 22, 2010) Suffolk Police advise that County Street at Madison Avenue will be closed for the remainder of the day due to a vehicle/tractor trailer accident and diesel fuel leak.
