Suffolk to Conduct Pot Hole Blitz

SUFFOLK, VIRGINIA (March 23, 2011) March 28 through April 1, 2011, the Public Works, Roadway Operations Division will be conducting a "Pot Hole Blitz" campaign city wide. The City of Suffolk maintains nearly 1500 miles of roadways. During this Blitz, Maintenance staff will utilize all resources seeking and repairing pot holes throughout the city.

The public is invited to assist by nominating their favorite pot hole to aid the City in finding and repairing all roadway defects that exist at this time. Pot Holes can be nominated by any of several methods. First, call the Roadway Maintenance Hotline at 757-514-7600. This number is answered from 7 am to 4:00 pm week days and has an answering service during other hours. Or you may use the link on the City's website located at http://www.suffolk.va.us/pub_wks/pothole.html. Finally you can send an email to PWcontact@suffolkva.us.

Pot Hole patching is an ongoing process and the City will continue to respond to request submitted as they are received year round. Optimum pot hole patching requires warm dry conditions for the best performance of the repairs. Should the weather not be cooperating during the week of March 28 to April 1, then the following week, April 4 to 8 will be a continuation of the pot hole repair efforts.
