FARMERS' MARKET EXTENDED

SUFFOLK, VA: The Suffolk Farmers' Market will continue to operate through the fall on Saturdays from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. and Wednesdays from 3 p.m. to 6 p.m. with a variety of local produce, plants and pumpkins.

Launched in 2006, the Suffolk Farmers' Market is an open-air gathering place offering fresh, locally-grown foods, value-added products and hand-crafted goods. Held beneath brightly striped tents at "Market Park" (the mini-park adjacent to the Seaboard Station Railroad Museum at 326 N. Main Street), the Market is sponsored in part by the Obici Healthcare Foundation and is managed by the Suffolk Division of Tourism.

Vendors participating in the fall market include Acorn Hill Farms, Adams Seafood, Apron Strings, B&H Produce, Black Silhouettes, Golden Eagle Farm, Growing Green Acres, Hardy Family Farm, Munden Flowers & Jewelry, Noriega Farm, Perry Handbags, Prissy Chix, and Topknot Angora.
