Suffolk Work Zone Alert

SUFFOLK, VIRGINIA (November 9, 2010)—Suffolk Public Works and Public Utilities departments are working at a number of locations across the city today.

Utility crews are working on East Washington Street from Liberty Street to Pinner Street. That section of East Washington Street will be closed to thru traffic today through November 17th. During the closure, traffic will be detoured to Liberty Street, Bank Street, and Pinner Street. This closure is necessary for the completion of utility work.

Paving crews will be working on Whaleyville Boulevard between John T. Mullens and Boonetown Road. There will be a mobile operation using flaggers and a pilot vehicle. This paving operation will be southbound starting at 9 a.m. until 5 p.m.

Public Works road maintenance will have a mobile flagging operation with alternating lane closures on Box Elder Road between Quaker Drive and Leesville Road today and Wednesday from 8:30 a.m. until 3 p.m.

Traffic Engineering will have an alternating lane closure at the intersection of Kings Fork Road and Fire Station 6 affecting both directions on Kings Fork Road from 9 a.m. until 1 p.m.

Paving crews will have alternating lane closures on Kenyon Road between Lakeland High School and the railroad tracks for paving operations for the CenterPoint Project today through Friday, November 12 from 8:30 a.m. until 4 p.m.
