Suffolk Work Zone Alert

SUFFOLK, VIRGINIA (November 1, 2010)—Suffolk Public Works crews are making repairs on roadways across the city to help make sure your trips are smoother. Please watch out for workers at the following locations:

Crews will have the intersection of McKinley Avenue and Harrison Street to the dead end completely closed for a road cut and repair job from 7:30 a.m. until 3 p.m. Detours should be used on Garfield Avenue or Lincoln Avenue.

Workers are on Route 58 eastbound and will close the right lane for asphalt operations a half mile west of Lummis Road ending at Lummis Road from 7 a.m. until 9 a.m. Once complete, they will move to Route 58 westbound with a right lane closure for asphalt operations at Lummis Road extending 2 miles west from 9 a.m. until 5 p.m.

Road maintenance will have a flagger operation with alternating lane closures on Bennett's Pasture Road between Harbor Road and John Yeates Middle School from 9 a.m. until 2:30 p.m. for cleaning ditches.
