**POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAY – SUPER LOAD MOVE TOMORROW
MORNING**

SUFFOLK, Virginia (February 2, 2011) If you are traveling in the downtown area Tuesday morning, February 2, 2011, the Department of Public Works would like to make you aware of three super load moves that could possibly cause a delay in traffic. Three transformers - each measuring over 18' high, 80 feet long and weighing 397,000 pounds - are scheduled to be offloaded from the railroad on County Street. They will be traveling south on County Street to Hunter Street, then to Hosier Road and to the Substation. All transformers will be moved at the same time with certified escorts and Police Officers. This move is estimated to take place between 10:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m.
