SUFFOLK, Va. (March 23, 2010) Approximately 178 homes in the Holland area will be temporarily without water for approximately one hour on Thursday, March 25. The scheduled interruption will allow for the repairs to a pressure storage tank. Residences on the following streets are expected to be affected by the project: Tree Ln., Jolly Ln., Glen Haven Dr., Hickory Neck Ln., Crestwood Dr., Windmill Ln., Dutch Rd., Kingsale Rd., Holland Rd., S. Quay Rd., Rurtian Blvd., Netherland Dr., Peanut Ln. and Grainery St.

The shut down will take place during the day beginning at 10 a.m. with repairs anticipated to take approximately one hour. Public Utilities will be delivering door hangers to affected addresses tomorrow.
