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UPCOMING UTILITY WORK PLANNED

SUFFOLK, VIRGINIA (April 19, 2011) The Department of Public Utilities will be conducting repairs in the West Washington Street and Pinner Street area over the next two weeks. These repairs could have some impact on localized traffic.

This work will require traffic control efforts with some detouring of traffic during the day to complete the work. Each work area is anticipated to be completed in one day, weather permitting.

Week of April 25th

431 W. Washington Street (east of Library) – Work zone will require the detour of east and west bound thru traffic. West bound traffic will be detoured from W. Washington Street to Chestnut Street to Market Street to Henley Place back to W. Washington Street. East bound traffic to follow the same route in reverse. Access to the Library west of the work zone will be maintained.

242 W. Washington Street (west of Clay Street) – Work zone will require the detour of east bound thru traffic via South Street to Jackson Street to S. Saratoga Street back to W. Washington Street. West bound traffic will not be detoured.

141 W. Washington Street – Work zone will require the detour of east bound thru traffic via Saratoga Street to Market Street to N. Main Street back to W. Washington Street. Left turn lane from Saratoga Street to W. Washington Street will be closed. West bound traffic will not be detoured.

157 East Washington Street at Commerce St.– Work zone is within center turn lane, thru traffic to be maintained with no detours. Off duty police officer will assist with traffic control.

Week of May 2nd

318 Pinner Street (south of Newport Avenue) – Detour of Pinner Street thru traffic will be via Newport Avenue to Eugenia Street to Central Avenue.

106 Pinner Street - Detour of Pinner Street thru traffic will be by Moore Avenue to Finney Street.

Pinner Street (south of Kingsboro Street) -Maintain traffic by flagging, but detour of Pinner Street thru traffic may be necessary.

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
